
step one BUDGETING


## Step five PRESTART CONSULTATION

During the prestart phase, you'll sit down with a friendly prestart consultant to go through all your design choices, upgrades, and electrical layout. This is your chance to personalise your home - everything from taps and tiles to benchtops and paint colours is on the table.



Even better? Your home will now be fully secured—protected from the elements and locked up safe from curious eyes, so everything inside stays on track and looking great.




## step eight PRACTICAL COMPLETION INSPECTION
